The sole criterion for this class is the elegance of the picture presented by horse and rider. Attention may be paid to the rider's personal appearance but detailed inspection of rider or tack is not required. Fancy dress or period costume is not permitted. Competitors are required to walk, trot and canter. No individual show is required, but the Judge may ask groups of 3 or 4 riders to give short displays.

2 Special rosettes will be awarded to the highest placed Adult Member and the highest placed Junior Member of the SSA carrying their current Championship Points Cards.

Open to members and non-members of the SSA.

Competitors must wear a hat to current Safety Standard or above.

Class 11EQUITATION CHAMPIONSHIPS OPEN QUALIFYING CLASS

Run under SSA Rules defined in the current Member's Handbook. Open to SSA Members and Non-Members. Members carrying their current Championship Points Cards are eligible for SSA rosettes to 3rd Adult and 3rd Junior places and SSA

Championship Points. **Southernden Farm** offers a rosette to the highest placed Member aged under 14 on 1st January of the current year. **Side Saddle International** offer a rosette to the Adult Member and **Manor Grange Stud Show Centre** to the Junior Member, judged to be the best turned out.

Showing Rules

1. The Committee reserves the right to amalgamate or cancel any classes or prize money due to insufficient entries.
2. The decision of the Judge is final.
3. No claims entertained for anything that may happen to competitors, onlookers, their property, or horses in connection with , or arising out of this Show. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that each entrant and their animal have suitable third party insurance and that they shall indemnify the promoters against any legal action arising from any incident whatsoever.
4. No entries accepted without the correct entry fee.
5. Hats to current British Safety Standards must be worn at all times when mounted - All handlers under 18 years **must** wear a safety hat, it is advised that all other handlers also wear a suitable safety hat .
6. All ridden horses and ponies must be 4 years of age or over.
7. For all Mountain and Moorland classes: Small breeds are - Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh A & B and Shetland (inc. Miniatures). Large breeds - Dales, Fell, New Forest, Welsh C & D, Connemara and Highland.
8. All Mountain and Moorland ponies entering classes 1 & 2 must be registered with their respective Society.
9. No Stallions over 2 years.
10. All animals must be halter broken and quiet.
11. Classes 14, 16 and 21- Ponies are 14.2h and under, riders 16 years and under. Horses are over 14.2h, riders any age. Mountain and Moorland classes riders may be any age, but must 'fit'the pony.
12. Foals to be shown with dam. Mares with foal at foot must be 4 years or over.
13. The Judge or his nominee may ride entries in the horse classes
14. All ages taken as at 1st January in the current year.
15. Class 6 - no skewbalds or piebalds. Spotted, duns, palominos, roans, etc allowed.
